School board member Zucker elected to serve as a director of state association

TALLAHASSEE – Caroline Zucker, a member of the School Board of Sarasota County, has been elected to serve a two-year term on the board of directors of the Florida School Boards Association. Zucker will represent District 24, which includes the school districts of Sarasota and Charlotte counties.

Zucker previously served on the School Board of Sarasota County from 1992 to 2000 and was re-elected in November of 2006. She served two previous terms as a director for District 24, in 1998-2000 and in 2007-2008.

“Change can only be accomplished through active participation, and serving on the FSBA board of directors gives me the opportunity to ensure that there is a voice from Sarasota and Charlotte counties representing our students, parents, teachers and administrators,” said Zucker.

The FSBA board of directors meets four times annually to establish positions and provide direction on major issues that directly impact the association's activities. The board is composed of five executive officers (the executive committee), 24 directors representing geographical districts in the state, and FSBA members who serve as officers or on the board of directors of the National School Boards Association or the Southern Region School Boards Association.

The goals of the FSBA include impacting legislation, developing effective board members, advocating for public education, and providing effective and efficient operations within the organization.
